Honors Leadership Program

The Honors and Scholars Program is looking for a graduate student to assist with the Honors Leadership Program. This is one of two new programs launching in the Fall of 2017. The Honors Leadership Program is an opportunity for undergraduate students to engage in holistic leadership development through a four-year cohort model program. Students selected for the HLP will earn an Honors Leadership Studies Minor through the Educational Leadership and Policy Studies Department and the Center for Leadership and Service. In addition to completing the Honors Leadership Studies Minor, students in the HLP will also complete co-curricular leadership experiences to compliment their curricular studies. The HLP culminates with students applying their leadership knowledge and skills in a final capstone experience.

GSA Responsibilities

- Facilitating leadership development workshops
- Honors Advising
- Developing programming for the Honors Leadership students
- Assisting with curriculum development, assessment, and semesterly reviews of student progress

Required Qualifications

- Must be enrolled in a graduate program at the University of Tennessee by the fall semester of 2017
- Strong written & oral communication skills
- Commitment to supporting student success

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience with leadership development on a college campus (personal undergraduate experience included)
- Previous experience working with undergraduate college students
- Event planning
- Academic Advising

This is a 9-month position with a salary of \$15 an hour for 20 hours a week. This position does NOT carry a tuition waiver.
