It is a pleasure to send you this important information about The Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi Fellowship competition. We would appreciate if you could make this information available in your office.

**The Phi Kappa Phi Fellowship program awards \$330,000 annually to 60 Fellowship recipients:**

- 57 Fellowships at \$5,000 each**
- 3 Fellowships at \$15,000 each**

The Fellowship program is designed to provide support to active Phi Kappa Phi members or prospective members as they prepare to enter graduate or professional studies in the upcoming 2010-2011 academic year. One requirement is that the applicant may not have earned more than seven (7) semester hours of graduate/professional school credits.

# FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

Every year, the Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi awards fifty-seven Fellowships of \$5,000 each and three at \$15,000 each to members entering the first year of graduate or professional study. Each Phi Kappa Phi chapter may select one candidate from among its local applicants to compete for the Society-wide awards.

## ELIGIBILITY

Open to all active Phi Kappa Phi members (annual dues paid through March 31, 2010) or those who have accepted membership by June 30, 2010. Applications will be accepted from individuals selected for membership but not yet initiated; see the application form for details.

Have applied to enroll as a full-time student in a post-baccalaureate program of study for the 2010-2011 academic year, preferably at an accredited American or international institution of higher learning.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Students registering in all professional and graduate fields are eligible.

Applicants who have already earned 8+ hours credit of graduate study or its equivalent before the 2010-2011 academic year are **NOT** eligible.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection is based on applicant's promise of success in graduate or professional study, including academic achievement, service and leadership experience, letters of recommendation, personal statement and career goals, and acceptance at an approved graduate or professional program.

All Fellowship recipients for the 2010-2011 academic year will be announced no later than May 1, 2010.
